What is **BVTeach**?

The **Brazos Valley Teach (BVTeach) Program** is a preapprenticeship / education and training academy for high school students. Founded in 2020 and funded by the Greater Texas Foundation, high schoolers participate in career and technical education (CTE), specifically education and training classes with a dual credit option. Students who successfully complete the courses earn a public service endorsement and/or educational aide certificate, and participate in practicum-based teaching experiences.

As a grow-your-own teaching program, BVTeach provides the *guidance, resources, and support* that high school students need to start college and careers in education as teachers, coaches, and early childhood educators.


Hearne HS Recruitment Presentation: 9.14.23



Externships







Hearne ISD, one of BVTeach's partner school districts, created a Nurturing Educators for Student Triumph (N.E.S.T.) Program, in which their vision is to provide a career path for Hearne ISD students to become Hearne ISD teachers. One element of this program is externships, where two of our BVTeach students, Fernanda Garcia and Kiyana Cooks, were able to intern at Hearne Elementary for three to four weeks this past summer and engage in various projects relevant to their fields of study. The following quotes come from the students' externship projects detailing their roles, responsibilities, and key learnings from their respective externships.



I feel that the school system makes most kids think that they need to only be at schools to learn and pass their classes, but it is so much more that that. Once I had gotten closer to each child that I was helping, they really liked talking with me. They wouldn't feel ashamed or embarrassed to tell me their stories. I was glad that I made them feel safe enough to confide in me.



I love helping the teachers, even if it's just a little bit, I enjoy every bit of it. Helping the teachers gave me a sense of comfort knowing that that can be me in the future just in case nursing does not work out for me. It's fun being a teacher helper.
